Ken opened the meeting and thanked everyone for coming.

Amit brought us up to date on the current issues within the buildings:

- The Hydro Vault – The wall which was in a bad way has been repaired. The hydro will at some time need to be down for 10-12 hours for the last work necessary on everything. Hydro will let us know when that is to take place. The tenants will be informed so they can plan for it.
- The gym is being upgraded. New equipment will be installed and the weights work out area will be in the space to the left of the PPL desk.
- The new windows have been budgeted for and work will begin next year. It will probably take 2-3 years as they will do ½ a building at a time.
- The new fans in the garages are being tested. At the moment they are running only when dangerous levels of carbon monoxide is detected. As so as the company completes its testing – hopefully in the next month – the fans will run continuously.
- Amit is going to look into the trash situation that has collected at the entrance to the fence and path off of Thorncliffe Park Dr. next to the parking lot south of our drive in.
- Hopefully the hallways will be finished by the end of the year. Hall vent fans are still being checked as people report them. Broken fan belts seem to be the main problem.
- Kitchen and bathroom vents are purely venting shafts. There are no extractor fans in them.

Pat Wright (Getaway Club) reported to us on the results from the Together Project which was presented last month. She said credit should be given to Morguard, the LTAA, and all our tenants who have contributed to a smooth a transition for our refugees as was possible.

- Since last month's presentation we know the U of T is now conducting a help session with math projects for kids in 4,5,6. In the party room.
- Wednesday and Thursday - Culture Link helps with acclimatizing mainly women living here in navigating most living situations here and in CA. They meet in the party room.
- Wednesday night grade 12 students from HS help refugee students in the Library.

- The library/café is still open 9-9 for everyone.
- At this time the library is welcoming new donations. Books wanted are children's books, novels, and Canadiana. PLEASE no magazines, journals or pamphlets. PLEASE put all donations and returns in the bin.
