Properly Reporting Maintenance Issues



Common issues that should be reported using the proper process:

- Pest control (rats, cockroaches, bedbugs, ants)
- Broken garbage chutes, messy garbage & recycling rooms
- Elevators out of service, lights not working
- Broken washers and dryers in the laundry rooms
- Do not assume someone else has already made a report!

Step One:

- Complete a work order
 - Can be done online via Resident Services Portal
 - Obtain a form from security
 - Obtain a form from the office

Step Two:

- Follow-Up with Morguard staff
 - If filed online, you can easily track the progress of every order you file
 - If you handed in a paper order and have not had it addressed within 7-10 days, call the office to ask for an update

Step Three:

- If work is not being completed
 - Contact 311 to file a Property Standards complaint
 - Contact RentSafe to file a complaint
